

Kindergarten Supply List

Individual teachers may request specific items not listed below.

- Crayons (Crayola 24 pack) two boxes
- Scissors (Fiskars blunt tip)
- White School Glue (Elmer's)
- Pencils ALREADY SHARPENED (1 pack)
- Pencil Sharpener (with cover)
- Eraser
- 1 plastic pencil case
- 2 Poly Portfolio Folder with 2 pockets and 3 metal prongs
- 2 reams of white photocopy paper
- 1 pack of clear plastic letter sheet protectors (min. 20 pack)
- Headphones (no earbuds)
- 1 bookbag (no rolling backpacks; no Pre-K back packs)

1st Grade Supply List

Items should be labeled with your child's name. All supplies should be brought to school by September 1st.
Individual teachers may request specific items not listed below.

- 1 pencil box (8"x5"x3")

- Blunt scissors (Fiskars preferred)
- White Elmer's glue (no colored glue)
- 2 glue sticks
- 1 pencil sharpener with cover
- 3 composition notebooks (no spiral notebooks)

- 1 backpack/bookbag (no rolling backpacks)
- 1 set of headphones (to use when on the computer)

2nd Grade

Supply List

- Book Bag (*No rolling book bags allowed)
- Jack D. Gordon School Agenda (to purchase through PTA)
- ZIPPERED PENCIL CASE/PENCIL BOX with:
 - Sharpened pencils/mechanical pencils (to be replaced throughout the year,)
 - Erasers
 - sharpener with cover to hold shavings
 - 1 pack of red pens
 - 3 different colored highlighters
 - 1 box of 24 crayons
 - 1 pack of colored pencils
 - 1 pack of glue sticks
 - 1 bottle of glue
 - scissors

The following school materials will be kept in class and/or book bag:

- 4 plastic duo-tang folders with pockets and fasteners (filled with wide-ruled notebook paper)
- 3 composition books
- 1 pack of sheet protectors (25 count)

- 1 Large eraser (*not* a pencil-top eraser)
